Bamberg, Germany

Rauchbier | 6.6% abv | \$7

Challenging? Yes. But challenging in that *'But why can't I have one more slice of bacon?'* kind of way.

Smokey, malty, tasty and rich.

Allagash Odyssey

Portland, Maine

Strong Dark Ale | 10.3% abv | \$25 (750ml)

Luscious fruit flavor with a nice oaky finish from one of the best breweries in the country.

Aventinus Weizen-Eisbock

Kelheim, Germany

Eisbock | 12% abv | \$7

Huge concentration of dark fruit flavors and a very pleasant warming finish.

Avery Mephestopheles

Boulder, Colorado

Imperial Stout | 15.4% abv | \$14

Massive imperial stout with a heady complex aroma and flavor. Expect rum, chocolate, dark fruit, coffee and um... oh yeah booze.

Ayinger Brau Weisse

Aying, Germany

Hefe Weizen | 5.1% abv | \$6

Arguably the best Hefe Weizen in the world.

BFM La Meule

Saignelégier, Switzerland

Golden Ale/Herbed | 6% abv | \$9

Brewed with dried sage. Calling this herbaceous might be a bit obvious, but it's true. Thoroughly delicious and not gimmicky in the least. Ultra dry finish.

Boon Framboise

Lembeek, Belgium

Fruit Lambic | 5% abv | \$12

Unlike the ubiquitous sugary sweet fruit lambics we've all had, Boon uses nothing but fresh raspberries added to an expertly blended lambic. Nice sour flavor with a sweet compliment.

Boon Oude Gueuze

Lembeek, Belgium

Gueuze | 6% abv | \$12

A traditional fruit-free lambic. Initial farmhouse funk with a distinct lemony finish. Well paired with shellfish.

Brasserie Ellezelloise Hercule Stout

Ellezelloise, Belgium

Russian Imperial Stout | 9% abv | \$11

Highly sought after Stout from one of the smallest breweries in the world. Big roasted flavor with a firm hop backbone. Perfect with (or for) dessert.

Brooklyn Brewery Local 1

Brooklyn, New York

Belgian-style Saison | 9% abv | \$16 (750ml)

Dry, light and peppery, a must-try.

De Dolle Oerbier

Esen, Belgium

Belgian Strong Dark Ale | 9.5% abv | \$9

Nearly unclassifiable: Rich aroma with a nice round mouth feel. Complex flavor with a slightly sour finish.

De Dolle Arabier

Esen, Belgium

Belgian Strong Pale Ale | 7% abv | \$9

Incredibly hoppy, refreshing summer ale.

De Dolle Oerbier Gran Reserva

Esen, Belgium

Flemish Oud Bruin | 13% abv | \$18

Oerbier aged in Bordeaux barrels. High acidity, lots of fruit and very strong for such a smooth finish. Develops flavor and the alcohol mellows as it ages.

De Dolle Stille Nacht

Esen, Belgium

Belgian Strong Pale Ale | 12% abv | \$9

The long boil during production lends a Sauternes-like viscosity. A healthy dose of hops balances the sweetness.

De Ranke XX Bitter

Wevelgem, Belgium

Belgian IPA | 6.2% abv | \$7

The most bitter beer made in Belgium. Floral and bone dry.

Duvel

Breendonk-Puurs, Belgium

Strong Pale Ale | 8.5% abv | \$6

The quintessential Belgian Pale Ale. Crisp, refereshing, awesome.

Etienne Dupont Tripel Cidre

Normandy, France

Imperial Cider | 10% abv | \$13

Three rounds of fermentation with grapes added create an incredibly complex flavor that has a bone dry finish. Natural vigorous carbonation puts Champagne to shame.

Hannsen's Oudebetje

Dworp, Belgium

Blended Lambic | 6% abv | \$16

Made with strawberries (more apparent in the aroma than the taste). Excessively sour in the best way possible.

Hannsen's Oude Gueuze

Dworp, Belgium

Gueuze | 6% abv | \$16

Pucker up, butter cup.

Hitachino Ginger Beer

Ibaraki-ken Naka-gun, Japan

Spiced Beer | 7% abv | \$8

New style Japanese ale made with fresh ginger. Spicy and refreshing.

Jolly Pumpkin Bam Biere

Dexter Michigan

Barrel Aged Saison | 4.5% abv | \$18

Nice session beer with a distinct oak flavor, approaches sour but is refreshingly restrained.

J.W. Lees Harvest Ale {99}

Manchester, UK

English Barleywine | 11.5% abv | \$14

Brewed annually, the recipe changes slightly every year: so try both of our vintages! Always rich and sweet, but not overpowering. Huge port-like finish. A great beer for sharing.

La Fin Du Monde

Chambly, Quebec

Tripel | 9% abv | \$6

Maker of men, wrecker of homes. Overripe fruit and spice. Fair warning: We can't think of one person who hasn't found themselves in hot soup at home because of this big, yet wildly drinkable beer.

La Rulles Triple

Rulles-Habay, Belgium

Belgian Tripel | 8.4% abv | \$9

Complex, and spicy with a slight banana flavor. Finishes nice and dry.

Leipziger Gose

Leipzig, Germany

Gose | 4.6% abv | \$7

German wheat (*not a hefe weizen*) brewed with sea salt and coriander... crazy refreshing!

Monk's Café Flemish Sour Red Ale

Ertvelde, Belgium

Flemish Oud Bruin | 6% abv | \$5

Young and old barrel aged beer is blended to create this eminently quaffable refresher.

Orval {Min. One Year Vintage}

Villers-devant-Orval, Belgium

Belgian Pale Ale | 6.9% abv | \$8

A dry hopped trappist pale ale, intentionally dosed with Brett to give it a unique flavor that is often imitated but never duplicated. Spicy aroma, effervescent mouth feel and an elusive finish.

Oskar Blues Old Chub

Lyons, Colorado

Scotch Ale | 8% abv | \$5

Slightly smokey, rich flavor and boozy finish.

Beersel, Belgium

Gueuze | 6% abv | \$15

Do you like a good barnyard?
Have we got a Gueuze for you...

Petrus Oak Aged Pale Ale

Harelbeke-Bavikhove, Belgium

Flemish Oud Bruin | 7.3% abv | \$7

Bracingly sour with tons of fresh lemon
flavor and a nice oaky finish. Great for wine drinkers
who wish they were beer drinkers.

Piccolo Birrificio Seson

Apricale, Italy

Belgian-Style Saison | 6% abv | \$8

Brewed in Northern Italy with chinotto, juniper
berries and coriander aged in chardonnay barrels.

Port Older Viscosity

San Marcos, CA

Barrel Aged Imperial Stout | 12.5% abv | \$25

Deep, dark and complex.

Rochefort 6

Rochefort, Belgium

Belgian Strong Dark Ale | 7.5% abv | \$12

Complex flavor rich with dark fruit flavors. Bold,
but not so high in alcohol that you can't have
more than one.

Rodenbach Grand Cru

Roeselare, Belgium

Flemish Red Ale | 6% abv | \$16 (750ml)

The perfect marriage of young and old beer aged
in oak creates the perfect blend of sweet and sour.

Russian River Consecration

Santa Rosa, California

Wild Ale | 10% abv | \$20

Aged in oak barrels with currants. Made with a wide variety of yeasty critters. Never bother with wine again.

Russian River Damnation

Santa Rosa, California

Strong Pale Ale | 7.7% abv | \$10

A great interpretation of Belgian golden ale, with the bonus of being born in California hop country. Bottle fermented.

Russian River Redemption

Santa Rosa, California

Belgian-style Pale Ale | 5.15% abv | \$10

One of the best session beers in the country. Great mineral flavor with a dry, anise finish.

Russian River Sanctification

Santa Rosa, California

Wild Ale | 6.25% abv | \$20

This 100% Brett wild ale is sour, tart and bracing in a delicate, citrusy way.

Russian River Supplication

Santa Rosa, California

Wild Ale | 7% abv | \$20

Dark, aged in Pinot barrels with sour cherries. A combo of brettanomyces and multiple lactic acid bacterias give it that nice sour edge.

Saison Dupont

Tourpes-Leuze, Belgium

Farmhouse Ale | 6.5% abv | \$8

One of the most popular Belgian craft beers and one of our absolute favorites. Herbal and bright. Just get one, if you don't like it, you can punch one of us in the face*.

Samuel Smith's Organic Apple Cider

Tadcaster, UK

Cider | 5% abv | \$8

English Hard Cider made with fresh organic apples.

Samuel Smith's Stingo '09

Tadcaster, UK

Barrel Aged Old Ale | 9% abv | \$17

Aged for one year on oak. Obvious oak character, leathery aroma and a massive roasted flavor.

Samuel Smith's Taddy Porter

Tadcaster, UK

English Porter | 5% abv | \$6

Keeping the traditional English Porter alive and well. Huge roasted flavor with a medium body for maximum drinkability. Delicious and nutritious.

Sierra Nevada Torpedo Extra IPA

Chico, CA

IPA | 7.2% abv | \$5

Bold, assertive and full of flavor. Complex citrus, pine and herbal character.

Sly Fox 113 IPA

Royersford, Pennsylvania

IPA | 7% abv | \$4

One of the bolder IPAs made in PA.
Herbaceous and citrusy.

Sly Fox Pikeland Pils

Royersford, Pennsylvania

German-style Pilsner | 4.9% abv | \$4

Dry, floral, perfumy and arguably one
of the best Pils made in the United States.

St. Bernardus Prior 8

Watou, Belgium

Belgian Dubbel | 8.8% abv | \$8

Ruby hued ale that strikes the perfect balance
between sweet and sour. A house favorite.

't Smisje BBourgondier

Oudenaarde, Belgium

Belgian Quadrupel | 12% abv | \$10

Barleywine-esque, brewed with candi sugar,
Valerian and Lemon Balm. Huge tannic flavor.
Tread carefully: You won't taste any of the booze.

't Smisje Wostyntje

Oudenaarde, Belgium

Belgian Strong Pale Ale | 7% abv | \$8

Belgian pale ale brewed with mustard seed. Like
sipping a beer while munching a slathered pretzel.

Westmalle Dubbel

Malle, Belgium

Belgian Dubbel | 7% abv | \$9

The original Dubbel. Huge malty aroma balanced
by spice and a rich raisin flavor. Effervescent mouth
feel and a finish reminiscent of rum soaked prunes.
